### Course Objectives:

The primary purpose of this course is to introduce knowledge, skills and concepts that allow students to understand elementary-level (CEFR A2) phrases and expressions related to everyday life using the four skills (speaking, listening, reading and writing). This includes the comprehension of vocabulary related to immediate personal relevance and short social communicative exchanges.

### Course Description:

This introductory course forms the first part of the Oxford General English course of the Common First Year English Program. The course aims to familiarize the students with elementary English language skills. In addition, the course provides the students with the skills to write short paragraphs, understand short phrases, read simple texts, and communicate simple routine tasks.

The ELAN 3111 course is delivered through 15 hours of teaching a week, equivalent to 3 credit hours. The material used is the New Headway Plus Special Edition **Elementary** student's book and workbook authored by John and Liz Soars and published by Oxford University Press.
