Course Objectives:

The second pre-intermediate part of the Oxford General English course consolidates the elementary English language skills studied in the first course. In addition, the course provides the students with the skills to write short, structured paragraphs, understand short phrases, read and write simple (CEFR B1 level) texts, and communicate on a range of topics, describing experiences and events, hopes and ambitions.

During this course, students develop their skills for CEFR level (B1). This level (B1) continues into the third semester, where the skills are further consolidated.

Course Description:

This is the second part of the introductory General English course that consolidates the basic English language skills studied in the first course. In addition, the course provides the students the skills to write short, structured paragraphs, understand short phrases, read simple texts, and communicate simple routine tasks.

The ELAN 3112 course is delivered through 15 hours of teaching a week, equivalent to 3 credit hours. The material used is the New Headway Plus Special Edition **Pre-Intermediate** student's book and workbook authored by John and Liz Soars and published by Oxford University Press.
